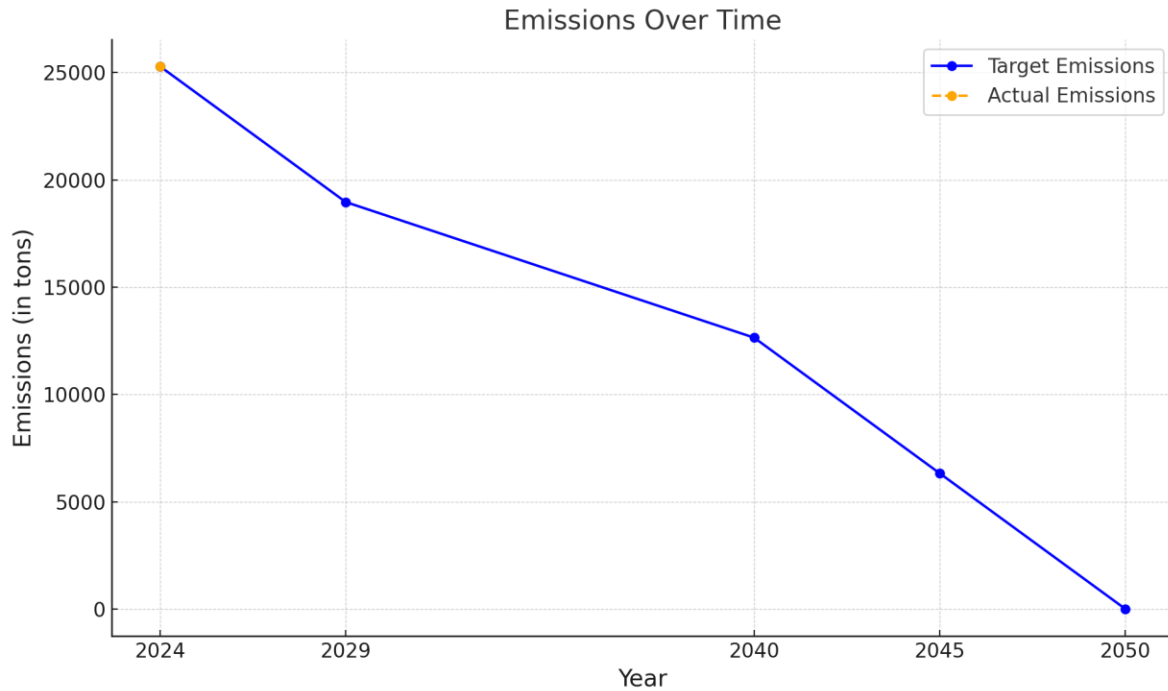
Baseline Emissions Footprint

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations:	
This is our first-year reporting emissions, and our baseline has been established using the most accurate data available. As there was no prior emissions reporting, this baseline serves as a starting point for tracking and managing our carbon reduction efforts. It reflects our current organizational structure and operations, providing a reliable foundation for future comparisons and progress assessment.

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 18,970 Kg CO2e by 2029. This is a reduction of 25%

Progress against these targets can be seen in the graph below:



This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard⁴ and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting⁵.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard⁶.
